Dear Parents/Carers, Welcome to Year 3

Topic Focus	Dynamic Earth
Subject	Main Learning Focus
English/Literacy	The whole class texts that we will be using this term are: Leon and Bob Princess Pigsty Pompeii Children will learn how to describe different characters and settings. They will learn about different word classes and using a range of prefixes. In addition, they will also write in a range of genres and have a variety of opportunities for speaking and listening. They will also be developing their understanding of grammar and sentence structure.
Maths	This term, children will be deepening their understanding of place value. Some of the objectives we will cover include ordering three digit numbers, reading and writing three digit numbers, identifying 10/100 more and less than a given number and identifying the value of each digit in a three digit number. We will also be exploring expanded methods for column addition and column subtraction. Children will be given lots of opportunities to apply these concepts in problem solving situations.
Science	Our topic for the first half term is Rocks and Soils. Children will have the opportunity to classify and explore different rock samples. They will devise investigations to test the hardness of different rocks and explore suitable uses for different rocks. Throughout this topic, children will be given lots of opportunities to develop their scientific enquiry skills. In the second half of the Autumn term, we will be learning about forces and magnets and will develop our investigative skills.
RE	Children will have the opportunity to learn about different Saints with particular emphases on the Patron Saints.
Computing	During this term, we will revisit the topic of e-safety. Children will be reminded of the importance of keeping themselves safe in the digital world. They will also be exploring different search engines for research purposes.
PSHE	This term's focus is beginning and belonging. Children have already created their class charters and thought about making people feel welcome. We will also spend time thinking about strategies to cope when we experience a new situation.
Art and DT	In Art, we will be exploring the work of the Japanese Artist Hokusai creating our own volcano artwork. We will also develop our drawing skills with a focus on drawing facial features and portraits.
History and Geography	We will be having a geographical focus this term. Children will learn about the location of earthquakes and volcanoes, how they are formed and how they impact upon the communities living nearby.
Music	As musicians we will learn a harvest song to perform in the harvest assembly. We will be exploring different rhythms and pulses and composing music.

PE	Our outside P.E. for the autumn term will be multi-skills. Children will develop their agility, hand eye co-ordination and ability to work as a team. Our inside PE will be

	rhythm, balance and co-ordination.
Modern	Children will have their first taster of learning Spanish. This will involve learning basic
Foreign	conversational phrases, the names of number and colours.

P.E. days/kits

Reading

Now that children are in year 3, they will be introduced to Accelerated Reader (AR). This is an online system where children take quizzes on the books that they have read. Children will be given AR targets to try and meet. When they reach these targets, they will be given a certificate and can help their class to earn rewards. New targets will then be set again in the Spring Term. Children will be given plenty of opportunity to complete the quizzes at school, so they are asked not to complete them at home. Even though children may wish to increasingly read independently now that they are in year 3, we do still encourage you to read with your child. Children can of course read books that are not on the AR system, but if you would like to check whether books you have at home are part of AR you can use the following website or search for Accelerated Reader Book Find UK.
