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Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you have enjoyed the weather this week and I know that many of you have taken advantage of getting out more. We should of course be breaking up today for half term but even though the situation is a little different at present I hope you all have a good week. Staff will not be setting any work for next week as we prepare for a possible re-opening from 1st June for certain year groups. Thank you for your patience and understanding during the past few weeks as guidance has been updated regularly due to changing circumstances. We will continue to keep you informed over half term if appropriate.

Re-Opening

As mentioned in yesterday's letter we will be open for the children of Key Workers and vulnerable children from Monday 1st June. If the Government decides that the scientific evidence shows it is safe for other children to attend then we will also welcome selected year groups back – only those who have booked a place. The school will continue to support those children in receipt of free school meals with vouchers if they are not in school as we understand that the scheme will remain in place until the end of the summer term.

I appreciate that there has been some concern over the very short deadline that was set in yesterday's letter but we were asked for the information earlier than we would have liked. Thank you for your understanding.

Childcare bookings for the Key Workers group listed in yesterday's letter will re-open from Tuesday 26th May. If the school does not re-open on 1st June we will open up bookings for all Key Workers as before. Please look out for information next week.
