Dear applicant,

Thank you for your interest in working at Brampton Village Primary School. We are a growing school which 'continues to be good' (Ofsted January 2017).

Brampton Village Primary School opened in September 2007 as a result of the amalgamation of Brampton Infant and Junior Schools. The school has been an important focus of village life since 1840, when Lady Olivia Bernard Sparrow founded a school in Brampton, and we enjoy a very good relationship with the local community. The original Victorian building is still an integral part of the school, but the majority of the buildings were constructed in the 1960s and 1970s. The school buildings have recently been joined, physically, by a new entrance and administration building. A new KS2 block was added in 2015 and we now have the capacity for 21 classes as we become three-form entry over the next few years.

There are 450 children on roll, aged 4 – 11 years, and over 65 members of staff. We also have 30 children registered at our Brambles Pre-School.

Brampton Village Primary School is a friendly, welcoming school which has a genuinely high regard for the well-being of children and staff. There is a strong team of teachers and teaching assistants whose dedication, creativity and effectiveness is highly valued.

Since September 2018 we have been running 18 classes across the school as we create extra capacity as a result of the extensive house building in the village. This TA 1:1 post has arisen as a result of a child moving into the school in Key Stage 1 who has an Education Health and Care Plan. The post is for 25 hours a week.
