

## PPA

 PPA is on a Monday afternoon when the children have PE with our sports coaches, Spanish with Mr Steward and Music with Mrs Crozier and Mrs Cunningham.







Our topic is Dynamic Earth

The children will be learning about the structure and formation of Volcanoes; their locations and the impact eruptions have on humans. Earthquakes will also be studied, reasons for their occurrence and impact on humans.







#### **English**

The whole class texts that we will be reading this term will include:

A selection of Poetry for Performance; Leon and the Place Between; Firebird and Pompeii.

Children will be performing and writing poems; describing different characters and settings; writing a narrative and a news report. In addition, they will have a variety of opportunities for speaking and listening. They will also be developing their understanding of grammar and sentence structure.

#### **Spellings**

Children will be given a list of 10 words (5 from Y1&2 NC list and 5 from Y3 & Y4 list) to learn each week. They will be expected to Look, Cover, Write & Check these each day – Mon to Thurs and then bring them to school ready for testing on Friday.





#### **Maths**

This term, children will be deepening their understanding of place value. Developing their methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication using formal column methods and also developing division through their knowledge of their multiplication facts. We will apply these skills in a range of problem solving contexts. Children will build on their knowledge of multiplication facts. By the end of the year 4 it is expected that children can recall all multiplication and division facts for up to 12 x 12.

#### Science

In Science we are classifying and comparing rocks; finding out how fossils are formed and learning about the scientific contributions made by Mary Anning; studying soil samples and understanding the composition.

Next half-term we will be focusing on States of Matter – reversible and irreversible changes.
