Thank you for your continued co-operation and support this week. You may be aware that Cambridgeshire and Peterborough have become an Enhanced Response Area (ERA), which means that more resources are available from the Government for additional measures to drive down recent rises in COVID-19 infection and to protect vulnerable people, the NHS and other vital services as the winter months approach. At the end of this week, we currently have 3 children isolating and 1 member of staff with confirmed cases of coronavirus. We will be maintaining our current preventative measures and will take further advice if needed.

Please keep your child at home if they are unwell or show signs of COVID. If someone in your house tests positive, please inform us immediately.

If a child becomes unwell or shows any symptoms of COVID-19 we will contact parents/carers immediately. We will then expect the process for booking a test to be followed. If there is a positive test then close contacts will be contacted by NHS Track and Trace.
