
What is remote learning?

Remote learning is learning from home when your child can't be at school because of Covid-19. While we are in lockdown and schools are not able to open (except to vulnerable and key workers) we will be continuing our learning remotely. This guidance should help you access the resources you will need.

What will remote learning look like?


You can access the remote learning activities using your child's Starz account. https://brampton.eschools.co.uk/login

Here you'll find a lot of useful web links on your home page and you can go to 'My class' to find your child's remote learning activities in 'Projects'.



Click on the current week's project to see the activities for the week and then click on the activities to view them.

Which activities do I need to do and when?

Each week we will provide lesson instructions for all subjects to explain learning for that week and what activities we would like your child to complete. We will also provide an example timetable so you can get an idea of what we would normally do at school and when.

Where possible, each day, we would like your child to read a book for 10 minutes or more and complete an English, Maths and Phonics activity. There will be lessons for other subjects (such as History, Science, Art, Music, PE, RE and PSHE) which you can choose when to complete.

Reading

Children should read to an adult or to themselves for at least 10 minutes each day. Children may choose to read books you have at home or read books online using Oxford Owl or Collins E-books. You can access both of these websites from the Starz homepage - please email your child's class teacher if you have any trouble with this. Please continue to record reading in the reading diaries 5 times per week so that your child can be awarded certificates for their reading when they return to school.

Maths

At school we plan our lessons based on a scheme called 'White Rose'. In 'Projects', there will be a link to watch a teaching video for each day created by White Rose and a worksheet or activity instructions to go with it. There will be three activity levels for you to choose from (Challenge 1, Challenge 2 and Challenge 3), please choose the right level for your child.

English

You will find links to online videos either created by a teacher or Oak Academy and an activity booklet to complete.

Phonics

We will upload a phonics PowerPoint and a teaching video of a teacher using the PowerPoint to teach a pre-recorded lesson, you can choose to either use the PowerPoint or video. We would like your child to complete a phonics activity each day, which they can choose from the 'Phonics Activity Menu' that we provide each week. You can also click on the Phonics Play link on the home page for some fun games.

What if I can't do all of that every day?

Our aim is to provide your child with at least three hours' worth of work a day, so that if you can support your child's learning every day you will not run out of work. We understand that sometimes family members may be unwell, working from home, or for other reasons it may not be possible to complete everything provided in 'Projects'. Not completing all tasks is absolutely fine, but please complete at least one task a day and keep in regular contact with your class teacher via emails or Starz messages.

Who will see the work?

We expect to see the children's work that they are completing at home. Teachers will provide feedback on at least one piece of work a day. Please send the work (or a photo of the work) as an attachment in a Starz message to your child's class teacher.

What if my child gets stuck on work or does not understand work provided?

The teachers are all still be here (providing we are well) so email us a message using Starz or you're your child's class email account and we'll get back to you as soon as we can, during school hours.

What if I would like more activities?

There are lots of links on the home page your child could try for even more activities.

What if I can't print the activities?

You can email <u>closure@brampton.cambs.sch.uk</u> to request a learning pack. When you request a learning pack you will be added to a list and will have one made for you each week. Please be aware that if learning packs are not collected we will not be able to continue making them for you. Learning packs will have your child's name on and will be available to collect from the office foyer.

Zoom meetings

Each class will have a 'Zoom' call at 1pm each day. The Zoom links have already been sent via Starz but if you are unsure on your class meeting details, please email the class email address. Please support your child to attend as many 'Zoom' calls as they can but don't panic if you can't do it every day.
