Cleaning and	We will maintain hygiene control measures which include:			
Hygiene	- Cleaning hands thoroughly and regularly.			
	 Ensuring good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach. Maintaining enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces, throughout the day. 			
	- Ensuring spaces are well ventilated.			
	- If any child shows symptoms we will contact parents immediately.			
Uniform	This year it has been very successful with the children wearing PE kits to school on PE days so			
	we plan to continue with this. On all other days the children are to wear school uniform but on PE days they should come in PE kits to avoid the need to change. Please be prepared for all			
	weathers. You will be notified of PE days at the start of next term.			
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	Children should wear appropriate shoes, no jewellery, except for watches and stud earrings or			
	make-up or accessories. If you are planning on having your child's ears pierced, please do this			
	over the summer so that they do not have to miss PE lessons because they cannot remove their			
	earrings.
