Topic: 'Spring' Main Text: 'Mud' by Mary Lyn Ray

This week we have learnt that mud is earth that is mixed with water and that people dig in the mud so that they can plant seeds to grow vegetables and flowers. We discovered that worms live in mud and soil and make horizontal burrows and burrow deep in the soil. We looked closely at a worm and observed that it has a pointed head and a slightly round body.
