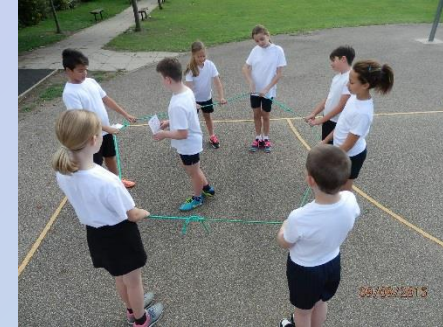

- If you need to contact us, the teachers are available at the end of the day or you can send messages to or via the Office.



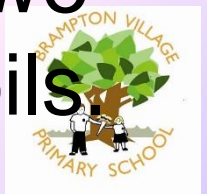
The Curriculum



In literacy, we be using a variety of different texts to support our learning. We will also be developing our spelling, handwriting and grammar skills.

In maths, we will be covering place value, adding and subtracting, multiplication and division.

Our topic is Dynamic Earth during which we will be looking at volcanoes, rocks and soils

Expectations

Behaviour: The children will be expected to follow the school code. Children worked together at the beginning of term to establish an agreed set of rules.

Work: The work is differentiated to meet the needs of all children, but children are expected to try their hardest and be resilient. We have high expectations of presentation and throughout the year, children will develop their joined handwriting.

Attitude: Children are encouraged to use the 5rs around school and we celebrate achievements in our Friday assembly.



How you can help

At home: Please read with your child regularly and discuss the book as you read along. Children can borrow books from school or read their own books. You can check whether a book is on the AR system online. All AR tests will be taken at school but you can see how your child is doing by logging onto the AR website.



Homework

- Reading – you have received a letter with your log on details for Accelerated Reader. This will enable you to see how your child is doing with their reading.
- Use of Learning Logs – our new way of doing homework. Children will be given open projects every two weeks to research and find resourceful ways of sharing it.



Attendance and Uniform

- Please help us by ensuring that your child is on time for the start of the day. Lessons start at 9.00am.
- Requests for term-time absence should be in writing to the Headteacher, using the form available from the Office or website. They are only authorised in 'exceptional circumstances'.
- Last year our attendance rate was 96.2%.
