





Routines

- As a general rule Maths and English lessons are timetabled in the mornings.

Expectations

Behaviour: The children will be expected to follow the school code. Children worked together at the beginning of term to establish an agreed set of rules which we call our Class Charter.

Work: The work is differentiated to meet the needs of all children, but children are expected to try their hardest and be resilient. We have high expectations of presentation.

Attitude: Children are encouraged to use the 6Rs around school and we celebrate achievements in our Friday assembly. Children is Year 5 and 6 can earn 'dojo' points for showing the 6Rs in class and around the school. Dojos lead to house points!
