Mrs Thilini is the Teaching Assistant in 1 Beech. She will be able to help me too.



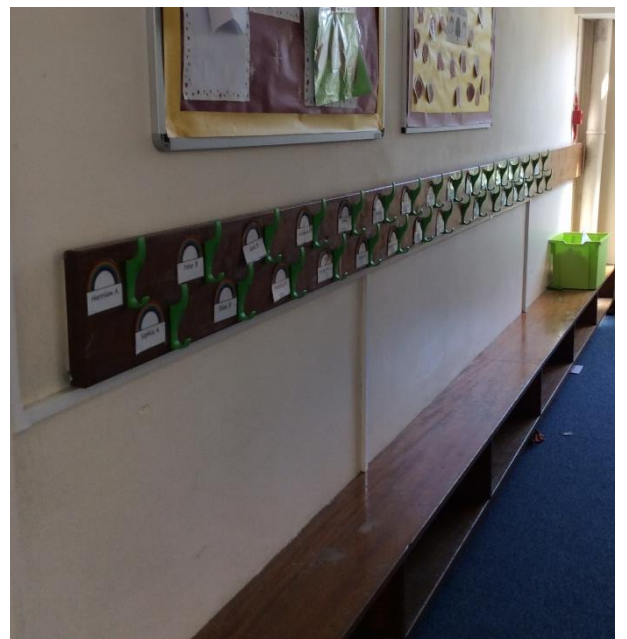
1 Beech Classroom

The Playground



This is the field and large playground that we use for playtime and outdoor PE.

Coming to school



I will arrive at school at 8:45am. I will walk through the gates and walk around to my classroom.

Mrs Murray will be waiting to welcome all the children at the door and Miss Ross will welcome all children into the classroom. She will ask me to come in. I will hang my coat and bag on my peg; and then go into the classroom. There will be a colouring activity for me to do at my table on my first day.

Snack and Playtime

We tidy up and wash our hands at 10.30.

Then we have a snack in the classroom, sitting at our tables. Some children have milk, some have water.

When we have finished our snack, we wash our hands and go outside to the playground to play with the other children who are in our bubble.

At the end of play, the teacher on duty blows a whistle. When I hear it, I need to stop and listen. The teacher then asks the children to go to their lines. I will line up with the rest of 1 Beech, ready to go back into class. When we get back into the classroom I will need to sit on the carpet and be ready to listen.

Lunchtimes

When it is lunchtime, I will need to tidy my things away and wash my hands. We will line up quietly and walk to the hall to eat our lunch with the rest of year 1. When I am in the hall I must listen to the grown-ups and follow our school rules.



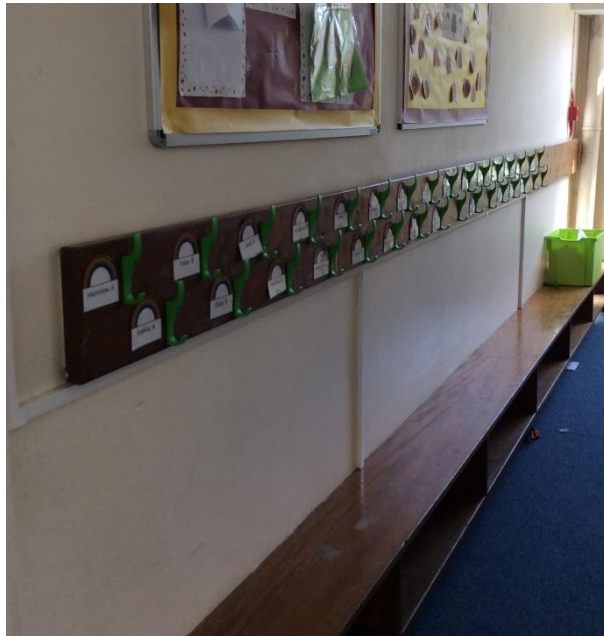
When we have finished our lunch, we can go out to play on the playground.
