Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you about the class structure from September 2018 when the school continues its expansion. It is planned for there to be three classes in each year group when we are at full capacity and from September 2018 we are increasing from 17 to 18 classes. The Local Authority has provided additional funding for the next year to support this growth, with certain conditions, and it therefore means that we need to change how the classes are structured.

Although mixed-aged classes may be new for Brampton it is standard practice in many other schools. All teachers are responsible for the individual development of every child in their class and mixed year group classes do not change this. We are very fortunate to already have a strong staff team for the next academic year and there will be new staff joining us as well. There will be a short meeting which is open to all parents on Wednesday 20th June, at 5.00pm and then repeated at 7.00pm. This will be an opportunity to meet with Governors and hear more about the plans for 2018-2019.
