Headteacher's notes...

It's been quite a week – visits, tournaments, visitors and very high temperatures! The children have dealt with the hot weather very well and we have made sure that they have kept in the shade and had plenty to drink. It doesn't seem possible that we have started our 'Getting to Know You' sessions for children starting in September but it is a reminder

that the term is going very quickly.



Year 6 have had a fantastic time away at Shugborough this week and have challenged themselves with all the activities. Thank you to the staff and adults who have been away with the children and supported them.



We had some sports science equipment on Tuesday morning for some of the children to try out and two rugby teams from Year 4 represented the school at a tournament organised by Northampton Saints, playing very well. Our Y5 footballers got through to the semi-final of the cup competition after a very tense penalty shoot-out that probably lasted as long as the match itself! Well done to all those involved and who helped in any way.

Year 3 and Year 4 have been able to enjoy their visit to Hinchingbrooke Park today and 3W led our Assembly on Wednesday morning very well, sharing all their work with us.

Next week RB lead Assembly on Wednesday morning at 9.15am and then we have Sports Day for Reception and Key Stage 1 on Thursday afternoon when the children need to come to school in their PE kits. We finish on Friday afternoon with an Assembly led by a Christian group called *Gen R 8*. The theme is 'Peer Pressure' and focuses on doing the right thing and making good choices regardless of what others say or do.

Once again we are reminding all parents and carers to take extra care when crossing the road outside of school especially at junctions and where there are speed bumps. Please do not assume that cars will stop automatically to let you cross.

School Trips

We always try to enrich the curriculum for the children through going on visits out of school or having visitors in school. We do try to keep costs to a minimum as we realise that these are challenging times for many families. In order for trips to go ahead the Governors have agreed that we need to meet 90% of the costs through parental contributions but even then there is a cost to the school.

The Year 1 'History Off The Page Seaside Day' on **14**th **July** has met the 90% threshold but the Mexicolore visit is at 79% and will unfortunately have to be cancelled on Monday if we are not able to meet the 90%. The PTA kindly provides money for each class each year to subsidise visits but these funds have already been used. We recognise that the contributions are voluntary but without them we are not able to fund any visits.
