They will accept the following 'good quality' items for RE-USE*:

- * Men's, Ladies' and Children's clothing
- * Paired shoes (tied together or elastic band around)
- * Handbags
- * Hats
- * Bags
- * Scarves and ties
- * Jewellery
- * Lingerie
- * Socks
- * Belts
- * Soft toys
- * Household linen
- * Household curtains
- * Household towels
- * Household bedding (bed sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers)

They DO NOT accept:

- * *Duvets and blankets*
- * *Pillows and cushions*
- * *Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)*
- * *Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing*
- * *School uniforms with and without logo*
- * *Corporate clothing and workwear*
- * *Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material*
