## Headteacher's notes



We have welcomed all the new children to Reception and Brambles this week, meaning that our school is fully up and running for the first time since March. All the children across the school have been fantastic in the way that they have adapted to different routines and systems and they have already produced some great pieces of work. You should be receiving letters today from each Year Group or Phase about the work that will be covered this term. There is lots to look forward to!



We know that there continues to be uncertainty and speculation in the news every day and a number of children have been off school already with colds and sore throats. We are following the latest Local Authority and Public Health England advice, highlighted in the 'Quick Guide to Parents' that was sent home earlier this week – this is also available on the front page of the website.

If the school is notified of a **possible** or **confirmed** case of coronavirus, or an individual develops symptoms in line with the guide, then the individual concerned will be sent home and asked to self-isolate for 10 days. They will be asked to arrange a test at the earliest convenience and to share the results with the school.

The parents/carers of other children within the same bubble will be sent a letter to notify them of this situation however the individual will not be named. All other children within the bubble will be able to continue to attend school as normal whilst the test is carried out and until the result is known. If there is a confirmed case then we will take further advice from the Local Authority.

So far there have been no confirmed cases in school but we must all continue to follow the procedures we have set up and follow social distancing.

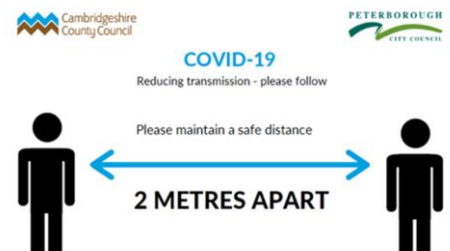
## Keeping Children Safe Online
