

### Headteacher's notes...

One of the privileges of being out and about at the start of the school day is welcoming the children to school and so many of them are so polite in saying 'Good Morning', even on a damp morning! It is great to see how independent they have become in making their own way in and going to their classes, whatever their age, and this is all part of growing up. Next week is our last week before we break up for half term and I know that the teachers are looking forward to talking with many of you next week at Parent Consultations, even though they may be a little different from usual.

The Leadership Team have met this week to review arrangements for after half term and I will write with more details next week. There are unlikely to be any significant changes except for some slight alterations at the start and end of the day. Despite the endless coverage in the media we are not aware of anything changing with regards to schools at the moment. We all need to continue to follow the guidelines, both in and out of school.



### Reminders

Please can I remind you all about safety in and around the school, both for yourselves and also the children. As a community we need everyone to help and be considerate of others, especially at this time. Thank you.

- Please do not walk through either car park, however tempting it may be for a short cut. They are for staff and visitors only and we have had some occasions when staff have been unable to park due to parents taking up spaces or near misses when people have nearly been hit.
- Bikes and scooters must not be ridden on the premises. Again, there have been some occasions when younger children especially have nearly knocked others over.
- The play and gym equipment should not be used either before school or after school as there is a risk of cross contamination.
- Dogs are not allowed on the school grounds, including the paths up to the gates.
- Please drive and park with consideration for pedestrians and other road users, not dropping children off outside the gates.
- Please leave the playgrounds as soon as your children are out of class so that social distancing can be maintained as much as possible.

In order to help the meetings go as smoothly as possible please follow the guidelines below.

- Adults should be responsible for setting up the call at home using the passwords and information supplied by the hosting teacher.
- Ideally devices should have recognizable names which are visible. Please can the children's name be displayed rather than generic 'iphone6' or 'admin' type names as these are not as safe for security reasons.
- Please make sure that you are in the 'waiting room' 10 minutes before your appointment. You will then be admitted by the teacher when it is time.

We would always prefer 'face-to-face' meetings but know that these are not possible at the moment. However, staff welcome the opportunity to discuss how your child has settled back into school and how they are working. We recognise that individual circumstances will vary considerably in the technology that families have access to and the available spaces in the family home and if using Zoom is not possible then please contact me at school.
