Something Special

On Monday we made our own poppy for Remembrance Day. We got to choose if we wanted to make a red one to remember the soldiers or a purple one to remember the animals who served and continue to serve.



We made a poppy at snack time from a digestive biscuit, icing, poppy seeds and cucumber for the green leaf.



In the afternoon a parent very kindly came in to show us her services uniform. We looked at the four golden buttons, noticed that they had wings on just like her hat and on her jacket and that she was wearing both a red poppy and also a blue 'bleuet' (like a cornflower) as this is what people in France wear as a symbol of remembrance.
