Funding Campaign

You will be aware of the march in London today that has been organised by the 'Worthless?' campaign. This is being attended by 1000 Headteachers, some of whom are from Cambridgeshire and they are marching in protest at the challenges that schools up and down the country are facing. A mixture of rising costs and stresses on other support services has meant that for many years we have been asked "to do more with less". The letter to parents from 'Worthless?' states:



Under a challenging period of austerity for the Government we understand that there is not a bottomless pit of money. Accordingly, schools have played their part to work even harder and with greater efficiency on behalf of the children and families that we serve.

It is clear to all Headteachers, however, that matters are unsustainable. Frequently, we do not have enough money to meet the demands placed on our schools. On the ground, services and resources are cut to the bone and class sizes are increasing. At times, schools are even having to prop up our budgets with monies that should be targeted at those students from the most disadvantaged backgrounds, or those that have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.

Under the umbrella of the campaign group 'Worth Less?', Headteachers have shone a light on the funding difficulties that we are facing. We acknowledge that the Government should be given credit for introducing a new National Funding Formula. Unfortunately, however, the formula itself is not adequately resourced/funded and therefore our budgets remain in an unacceptably poor state.

The support that we have enjoyed from parents and carers has been very welcome and we will continue to update you on all of our forthcoming actions. We are determined to campaign until a much better and fairer settlement is reached in order to support your child/children and the future prosperity of the country as a whole.

PTA NEWS

After our AGM on Tuesday, we are delighted to announce that Pete Robbins along with Victor Sacks will be joint Chair and Roxanne Pitteway will be joining us as secretary. Marrisa Harris will remain as Treasurer, but we will be needing a treasurer for next year as Marrisa has decided this will be her last.

The PTA will be looking for ideas as well as volunteers to come up with some fundraising activities and to help us with those we already have in the diary. We are for example, looking for our business owners, businesses in Brampton and Huntingdon who can sponsor our trips and experiences to ensure our children do not miss out on such events and might lead to the cessation of voluntary contributions for these trips, but that will only happen with parent/carer support.

Our first event is Cake Friday on 5th October with Years 3 and 4 doing the making and baking. For those new to the school, we do this 2 - 3 times a year, inviting a year once, to make cakes which are sold to pupils after school and funds received are then used by the PTA to help towards school trips, etc.

We will need some of you to come and help us set up, take money and clear away, so 'sign up Genie' will be available online, or feel free to come along to help us. As ever, we can't do anything without you and we look forward to a bumper year ahead.
