



Middle Phase Remote Learning



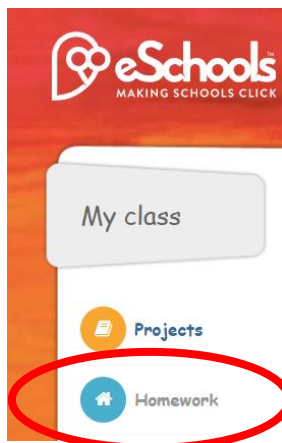
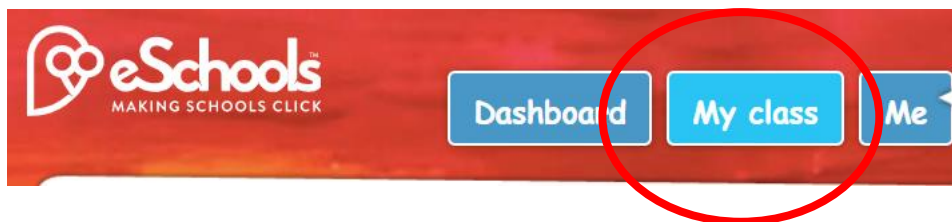
What is remote learning?

Due to the Coronavirus, some children may have to miss school while they isolate. This may be for a couple of days if they are waiting for test results or 2 weeks if a member of their household has had a positive test. Remote learning is learning from home when children can't be at school because of Covid-19.

What will remote learning look like?

Your child can access the home learning activities using their STARZ account login @ <https://brampton.eschools.co.uk/login>

Here they will find a lot of useful web links on the home page. Go to 'My class' to find the distance learning activities in the 'Homework' section.



Which activities do I need to do and when?

In the event that your child has to isolate, he or she will be provided with activities within *Homework* section of STARZ. They may also be signposted to resources online or in the *Projects* section.

Where possible, each day your child should complete an English, Maths as well as other activities such as topic, creative projects or Science. On the *Homepage* you will also find a links including TT Rock Stars. Please encourage your child to access these regularly. If your child has a *Nessy* account he/she should also access the reading and Spelling activities for 20 minutes each day.

Your child will be able to submit homework by uploading documents, videos or photos for the class teacher to review. This will then show as 'submitted'. Once received by the teacher the homework activity will show as 'completed'. Please note that children may be asked to submit via the messaging system in STARZ. In this case, instructions will be given when the activity is set.

Reading

Where possible, each day your child should read a book for 20 minutes. The children will still have access to the AR system to allow them to complete regular quizzes. Your child will also have access to reading comprehension activities to choose from. At least one should be completed each week.

Maths

Daily maths activities will be provided including video lessons and activities to complete. All links and instructions will be provided via STARZ.

English

We have English lessons four times a week at school. There will be enough resources, possible web links and activities available to complete four activities a week.

What if my child can't do all of that every day?

Our aim is to provide a full school days' worth of work so that *if* your child is able to home school every day, there will be enough work. We understand that some people are unwell, working from home etc so we understand that for some people they might not complete everything provided in projects. This is OK. Just do whatever you can, when you can.

Where should my child work and who will see it?

Children can choose to work on a digitally or on paper if this is preferred. We would ask that photos of paper based work be uploaded when the children submit in the *homework* section or via messaging as instructed. Your child's teacher will be able to access submitted work.

What if I get stuck on my work and I don't understand?

The teachers will be available (providing we are well) through the STARZ messaging app or via the class email addresses e.g. middleelem@brampton.cambs.sch.uk and will get back to you as soon as they can, during working hours.

What if I can't print the activities?

You can request a printed work pack, but you will need someone who is not isolating to collect it as soon as possible. These packs do take time to prepare so we would appreciate it if you only request one if you can't print or don't have a device to access the resources online.

What if my child's bubble is closed?

If the whole bubble is sent home to isolate then we will continue to send work via the STARZ in the same way. However, a comprehensive timetable of daily activities will be provided including links to daily online video sessions undertaken by the class teacher (health permitting). The children will be set a focused activity each day which the children will need to complete. Feedback will be given on this activity if submitted by 4pm on the day it is set. Further information will follow in this event.
