2 Beech Classroom



All of the children have pegs in the corridor outside the classroom. I will have a peg and this is where I will hang my bag and coat.





These are the toilets. If I need to go to the toilet, I must ask an adult, so that they know where I am. After I've been to the toilet, I will need to wash my hands.

We are cleaning our hands often, to help keep ourselves safe. Sometimes we use soap and water and sometimes we use hand sanitiser.

The Playground

Coming to school



I will arrive at school at 8:45am. I will walk through the gates and walk around to my classroom.

Mrs Smith will be waiting to welcome all the children at the door. She will ask me to come in. I will hang my coat and bag on my peg; and then go into the classroom, where Miss Wilkinson or Mrs Clipsham will be waiting. They will ask me to

Snack and Playtime

We tidy up and wash our hands at 10.30. Then we have a snack in the classroom, sitting at our tables. Some children have milk, some have water.

When we have finished our snack, we wash our hands and go outside to the playground.

At the end of play, the teacher on duty blows a whistle. When I hear it, I need to stop and listen. The teacher then asks the children to go to their lines. I will line up with the rest of 2 Beech, ready to go back into class.

When we go back into the classroom, I will need to sanitise my hands, before sitting back at my table.

Lunchtimes



When it is lunchtime, I will need to tidy my things away and wash my hands. We will line up and walk to the lunch hall where we eat our lunch.

If I have a packed lunch I will sit down straight away and eat my lunch. If I'm having a school dinner, I will line up to get my food. The midday supervisors will help me collect my food and show me where to sit down.

When I have eaten my lunch an adult will take me outside to the KS1 playground to play.

Going home

At home time, we'll collect our things and line up by the classroom door.

When we are ready Miss Wilkinson or Mrs Clipsham will take us out into the corridor and down to the door, where I will be collected.
