Subject	Main Learning Focus	
English	Writing Genres will include: Narrative, Instructions, Poetry, Myths & Legends, Non Chronological Report; Grammar & Spellings; Guided Reading; AR Reading.	
Maths	Place Value: Representing numbers; Partitioning; Counting; Comparing and Ordering; Finding 1 more / less; Roman Numerals.	
Science	Sound – how sounds are made; how sound travels; finding patterns between pitch & materials; patterns between the volume and the strength of vibrations.	
RE	Islam – Being a Muslim; Beliefs; Places; Festivals; Holy Books; Symbols.	
Computing	Staying Safe online; Use of Starz; Creating a blog.	
PSHE	Rights and responsibilities – differences; different views & beliefs; different national and ethnic communities.	
Art and DT	The children will be creating Roman Mosaics and Roman shields.	
History and Geography	Chronology; Britain pre-Roman invasion; Julius Caesar; Britain as part of the Roman Empire; Why the Roman Army was successful & the impact of the Romans in Britain.	
Music	How to use body percussion for a group composition based on layers of rhythms. Children will then use some pitched instruments and a variety of dynamics to make it expressive.	
PE	Pentathlon skills and Daily Mile.	
MFL	Spain as a country; revision of numbers, greeting; creating an ID card using knowledge gained in previous lessons.

## <u>Reading</u>

We will be continuing with the Accelerated Reader system this term. Your child will be bringing home a school reading book linked to the AR system along with a reading record. Please encourage regular independent reading of this book and reading to an adult wherever possible. As a guide your child should read at least five times a week at home and should be also aiming to read 100+ minutes each week. Please sign against the fifth home reading record entry as evidence that your child has read five times. This will also support your child in working towards meeting AR targets. Extra reading of home fiction, non-fiction, magazines and guides is of course encouraged and welcomed.

## PE days/kits

PE kits will be required on Monday for all classes. Please ensure that your children arrive wearing their PE kits on these days.

PE kit consists of - a white t-shirt, trainers, jogging bottoms/dark shorts and a sweatshirt.

No jewellery except stud earrings and watches should be worn in school and these must be removed for all PE activities as it is no longer acceptable to use tape to cover earrings. We would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Long hair must be tied back.
