




Optional KS1 Easter activity ideas.

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| <p>Design your own Easter Card.</p> | <p>Write a story about what might hatch out the eggs...</p>  | <p>Make some small card Easter eggs. Estimate putting them different distances apart e.g. 10cm, then measure how far apart they are.</p> |
| <p>Estimate then weigh an egg. You could compare different Easter eggs or even weigh a real egg.</p> | <p>Write your common exception word spellings on eggs. Place them in a basket, take a few out a time, can you read them / spell them. (You could also try this with the different phonemes).</p> | <p>Build a vehicle out of lego or knex which can save an egg in a crash! Could also be a small toy rather than an egg!</p>  |
| <p>How many books can you balance on egg shells?</p>  | <p>Practise drawing maps. Draw a map of the garden, then show where the eggs (could be pictures of eggs) are hiding on the map.</p> | <p>Write instructions for how to find the eggs.</p> |
