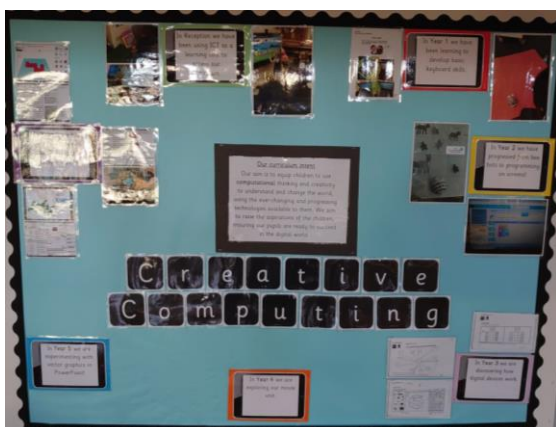
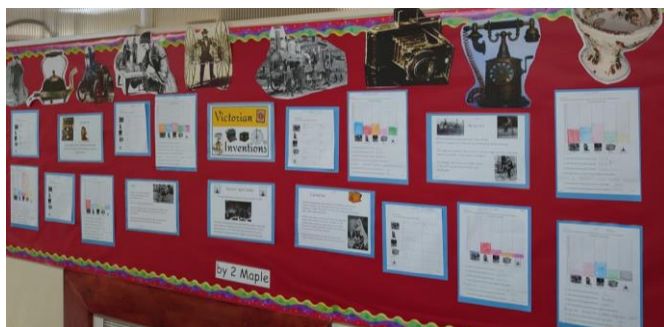
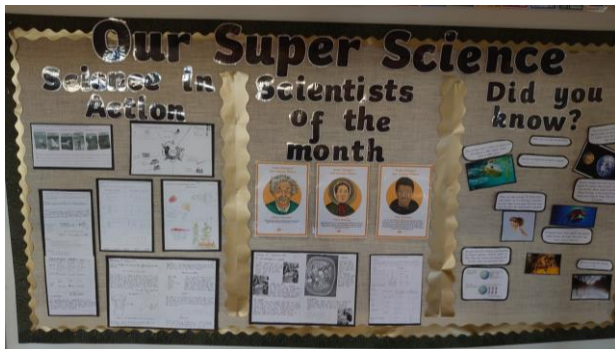

The deadline for applications for a place in Reception in September 2022 is 15<sup>th</sup> January.

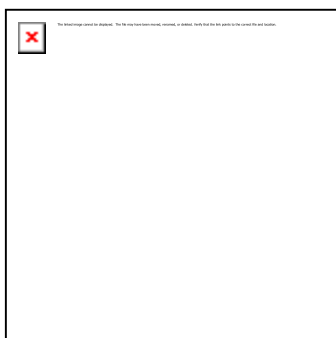
