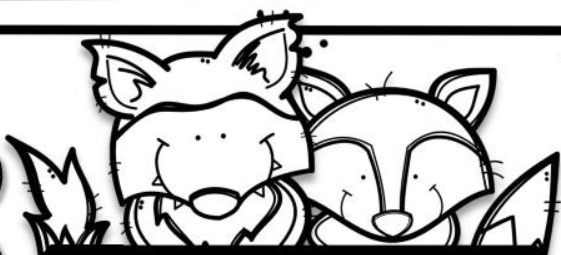

Learning Goals:

Topic: 'Summer' **Main Texts:** 'Thunderstorm Dancing' by Katrina Germein & Judy Watson and 'The Storm' by Akiko Miyakoshi

We learnt this week that the combination of water and electricity passing through clouds produces lightning. The electric boom of lightning heats up the atmosphere, causing the noise called thunder. We need two conditions for thunderstorms to happen: the air near the Earth's surface must be warm and moist (with lots of liquid). Storms can cause a lot of damage in the environment.

Miss Sallie made some thunder cake for us to try just like the one in the story called 'Thunder Cake' by Patricia Polacco that we saw on the screen after lunch.
