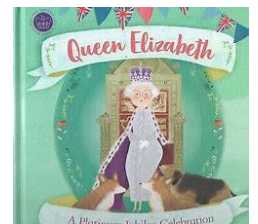

Following recent questions we wanted to clarify our policy on the wearing of earrings during PE. In line with many other schools our policy means that it is not acceptable to use tape to cover earrings. This applies in both PE lessons and at any clubs. We would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Any child who cannot remove their studs will be given another task to complete during the lesson. Whenever possible children should be able to remove their own jewellery before a PE lesson. If you plan to have your child's ears pierced, it would be helpful for this to take place at the start of the summer holiday so that the time is available before earrings can be removed.
