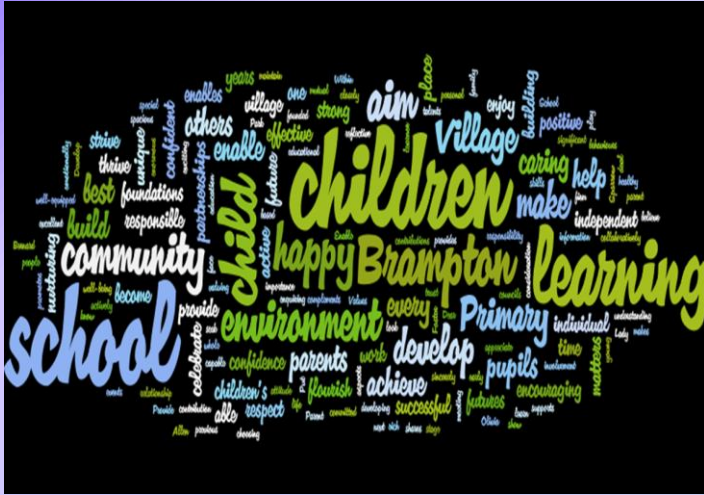

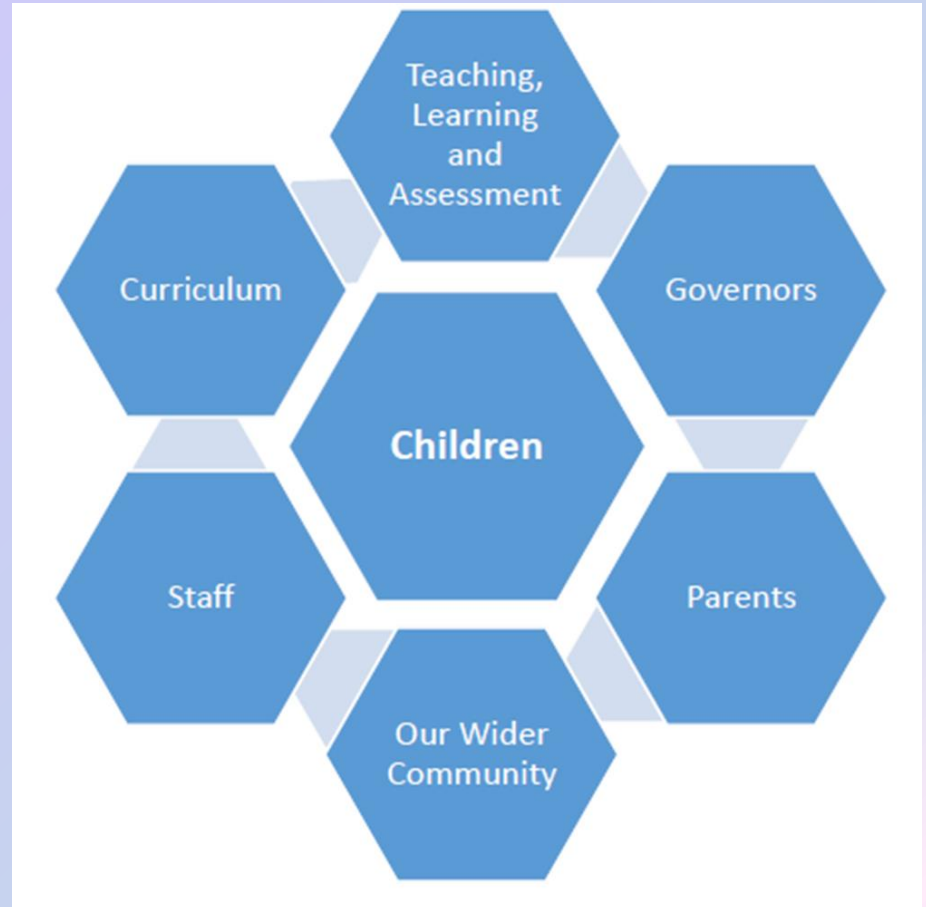

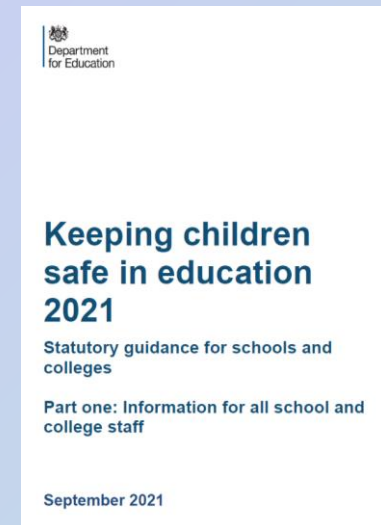


Safeguarding

- Uniquely positioned on school premises – children remain on site throughout the school day, safe within the school grounds.
- Well resourced to support all Primary age groups and abilities.

WHY CHOOSE BKC?



- In each of the last four years BKC has looked after between 20 and 25 Reception children each year. Nicola (co-owner of BKC) is also employed full time, as a Teaching Assistant in Reception, and provides continuity of support for all children, ensuring safeguarding is of the highest standard possible.
- On a daily basis, through our unique and privileged access to school, the children are escorted to their individual classes in the mornings and collected from each classroom in the afternoons.
- If you are looking for just one morning, one afternoon, a full week of childcare or something in between, we can help. All we need from you is a completed Childcare Request Form.

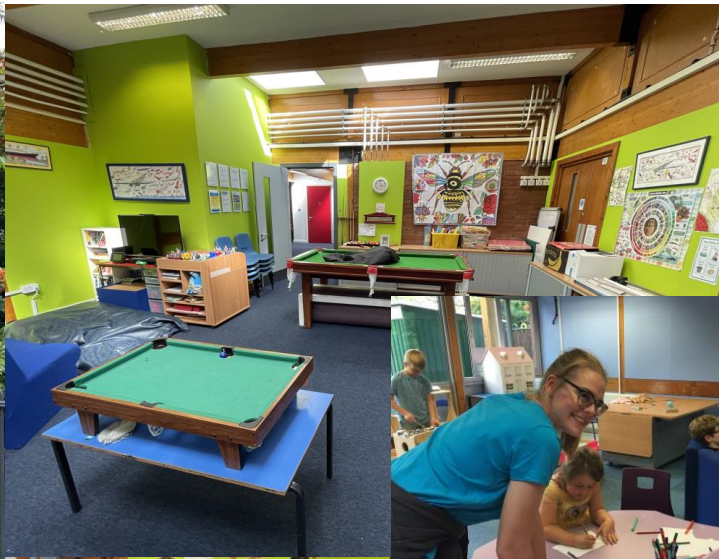

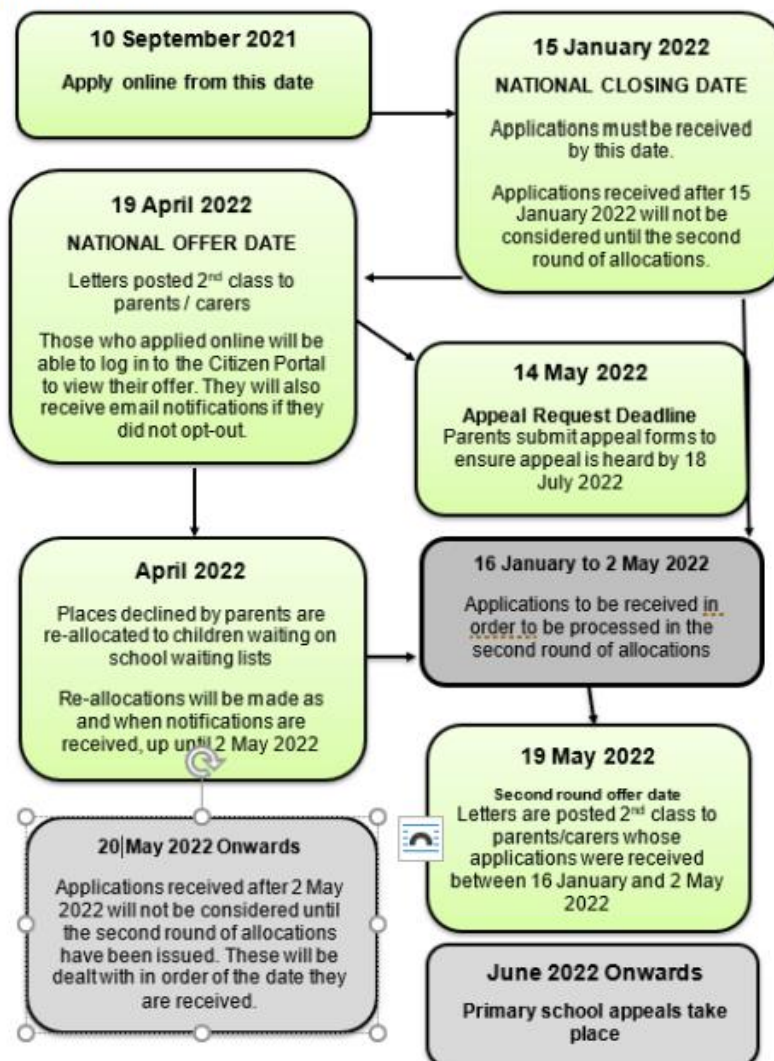
