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Headteacher's notes...

I don't know about you but it feels to me as if the Christmas and New Year holiday was a long time ago. Staff were in school on Monday all looking forward to welcoming the children back in on Tuesday when suddenly we had to re-plan and adjust to different circumstances. Last term there were so many positive things to celebrate and we all recognised how well the children had done since returning in September. It now feels as if we almost have to start again which is why keeping in touch with school and taking part in the remote learning each day is so important. Many of you have



asked for packs of work and these have been collected, along with blank exercise books. Further packs can be requested by contacting the school. We are trying to get further laptops and if you need a 4g router please let us know as we can also request these. In line with DFE guidance and our Remote Learning Policy, teachers are maintaining daily contact with children via Zoom, Teams, Office 365, Starz or Evidence Me. If teachers do not see or hear from children they will contact families initially by email and then telephone if there is no response. This is simply to maintain contact and not to check what work is being completed.
