Before the end of term we will be reviewing the outcomes of the various assessments that have been completed, to assess this academic year and in preparation for the next. We are pleased the current 21 single-age class structure will continue, facilitating stability.

Our work

Our main role is to oversee the strategic direction of the school and review progress. We publish each year's development priorities within our [School Development Plan](#), and monitor progress towards them through the year. We also monitor routine elements of school life, such as safeguarding, wellbeing, SEND and Pupil Premium provisions.

Last term we completed monitoring visits on: Safeguarding, Health & Safety, Pupil Premium provision, Catch-Up, Brambles, Maths, Phonics and English. Our monitoring reports are shared among the full Governing Body and reviewed by the Local Authority. They include any points of note to share and any follow-up monitoring required.
