Headteacher's notes...

It was great to be able to welcome so many of you to our Open Afternoon on Monday. I hope that you enjoyed the opportunity to see some of your children's work and also to read about their successes in their Annual Report. Thank you for all the positive comments on the report slips that have been returned this week – we have enjoyed reading them.

Year 2 enjoyed their visit to the Botanic Gardens in Cambridge on Tuesday and Wednesday and thank you to everyone who came along and helped. For many of the children this was their first experience of a school trip – let us hope there are more next year. Governors met for the last time this term on Monday and we also had the second PTA Disco which went very well.

The children are tired and many have been unwell with a variety of bugs as well as covid. We have also had a number of staff away from school which has impacted some of the things we have been able to do, we hope everyone is better soon. Next week is the last week of term with the last day being **Thursday 21**st **July**.

Weather

It has certainly been an exceptionally warm week. A number of parents have asked about whether the school will be open next week. There are no plans to close and any decision would be after any advice from the Local Authority which is being updated all the time. However, due to the hot temperatures expected, the children can come to school wearing non-uniform which will enable them to wear loose, light coloured clothing that will help keep them as cool as possible on Monday and Tuesday only. Appropriate clothing and sensible shoes must be worn in school, for example, no crop tops or very short shorts. At breaktimes staff will take the children outside to sit in the shade. Please remember to send your child in with a water bottle (no juice) and a hat. We will also postpone the KS2 singing planned for Monday afternoon but if we can we will try and reschedule it for later in the week.

This year our Year 6 Leavers' Evening is being held on **Wednesday 20th July**, and is expected to start at **6.00pm**. Due to the number of children involved and the capacity of the Hall, bookings are limited to strictly **2** per family.
