



Ticket bookings for these Christmas performances will be made using the website SchoolCloud - Brampton Village Primary School. If you experience difficulties or do not have access to a computer, please contact the school office.

The total number of seats that each family can book across the performances is as follows: Reception: 2 seats Year 1: 2 seats Year 2: 2 seats.

This means that families will need to decide who is attending which performance. Every year we get asked why we have to limit the number of seats. We are sure you can understand that with every child in these year groups taking part in a production or concert, our aim is to ensure that every child has someone there to watch them. We understand that some of you may be disappointed that not all family members are able to attend, however, the most important thing is that all children have someone there. In addition, for health and safety reasons, we have to ensure that we are able to evacuate the hall efficiently should we need to.

Younger siblings must have a seat, and we would discourage very young babies from attending as they can quite often be distracting for the children performing. No pushchairs can be brought into school for the performances as fire lanes must be kept clear. All children attending the school will see their siblings perform during the school day at the dress rehearsals.

You could choose to book both seats for the same performance or seats at different performances. We must stress that seat allocation is per family, not per child, and that there are 2 tickets in total per family.

We're pleased to confirm that the <u>Christmas HAF Programme</u> will run during the above dates. Eligible children can access up to 16 hours of funded holiday clubs and family experiences.

Bookings open on 10 November 2025, and eligibility vouchers will be shared with families in receipt of benefits-related free school meals.

We're also delighted to share that, as part of the government's Best Start in Life initiative, funding for the HAF Programme has been confirmed for the next three financial years, starting from 2026/27.
