We have enjoyed a good week in school and have welcomed back some children and staff who have been isolating. It has been great to see some of the clubs starting again. The number of cases across the school has fallen quite a lot with just 4 new cases since the weekend. We will continue to make sure everyone is as safe as possible and have the appropriate measures in place. Playing your part out of school is also important as we look to work together to keep us all well.

Thank you for keeping us informed when your child is absent. There are a number of bugs around and it is important that your child is well enough to attend school and that you contact us each day on pupilabsence@brampton.cambs.sch.uk if they are unwell.

This week we have been thinking about being 'Resourceful' when we 'explore different ways to get things done.' This may mean using different equipment or asking other people for ideas and suggestions if we are stuck. The children are always great at doing this!

This week the Governing Body met for their first meeting of the school year. As well as reviewing school priorities, Emma Spencer was re-elected as Chair and Ian Langworthy as Vice Chair.
