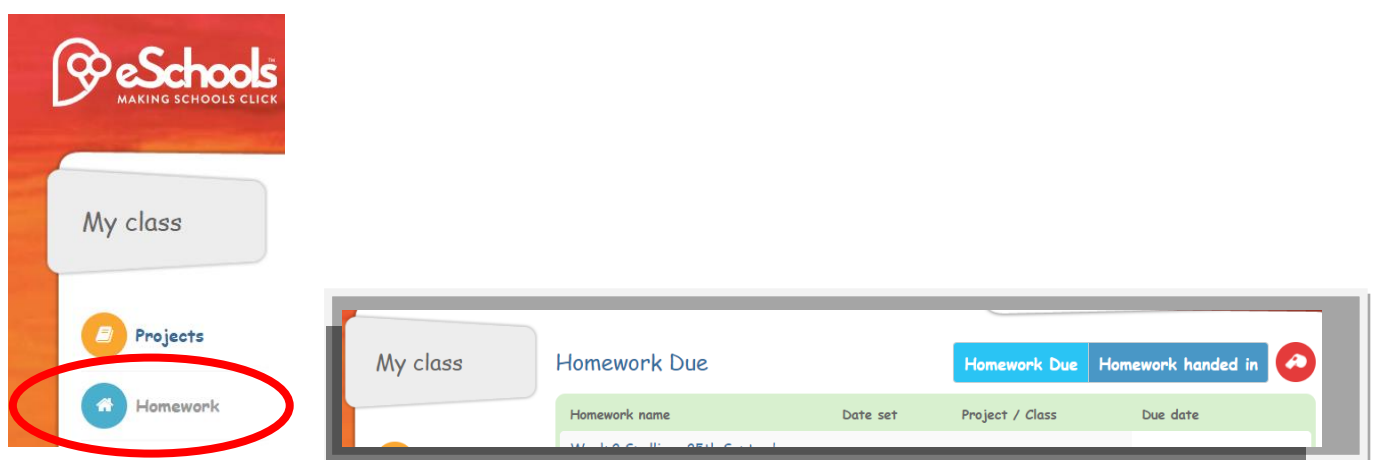
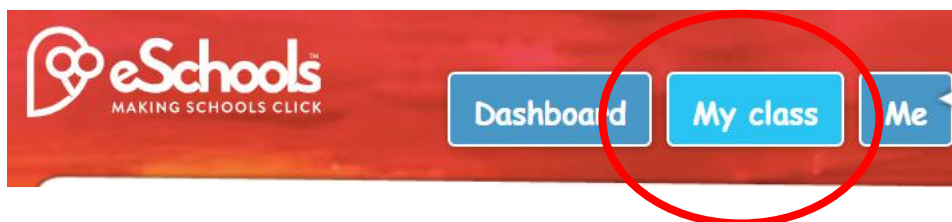
What is remote learning?

Remote learning is learning from home when children cannot be at school because of Covid-19.

What will remote learning look like?

Your child can access the home learning activities using their STARZ account login @ <https://brampton.eschools.co.uk/login>

Here they will find a lot of useful web links on the home page. Go to 'My class' to find the distance learning activities in the 'Homework' section.



Which activities does my child need to do and when?

Your child will be provided with activities within *Homework* section of STARZ. Where possible, each day your child should complete English and Maths tasks each day as well as other activities such as topic, creative projects or science.

On the homepage you will also find links including TT Rockstars. Please encourage your child to access these regularly. If your child has a *Nessy* account he/she should also access the reading and Spelling activities for 30 minutes each day.

Your child will be able to submit work by uploading documents, videos or photos for their class teacher to review. This will then show as 'submitted'. Once received by the teacher the work will show as 'completed'. Please note that children may be asked to submit via the messaging system in STARZ. In this case instructions will be given when the activity is set.

Reading

Each day your child should read for 30 minutes. The children will still have access to the AR system to allow them to complete regular quizzes. There will also be a weekly comprehension exercise for your child to complete to ensure that they are reading regularly. Your child also has access to the Collins Big Cat e-library and has been assigned a range of books, many of which are on the AR quiz system.

Maths

Daily maths activities will be provided. All links, resources and instructions will be available via STARZ.

English

We have English lessons four times a week at school. There will be enough resources, possible web links and activities available to complete four activities a week.

Other subjects

Other activities relating to subjects such as Science and Topic will be provided via the Homework Assignments on a weekly basis.

You also will find lots of fun websites to extend your child's learning with links to different websites on the STARZ class pages. There are a wide range of activities for your child to enjoy, including Scratch, Language Angels, AR, Ten Pieces Music, CBBC, Go Noodle and Cosmic Yoga. Your child will be able to submit any 'Your choice' work by uploading documents, videos or photos for the class teacher to review via STARZ messaging.

What if my child cannot do all the work that every day?

Our aim is to provide you with four hours' worth of work a day. We understand that sometimes family members may be unwell, working from home or for other reasons it may not be possible to complete everything provided. This is OK. Just do as much as you can, when you can.

Where should my child work and who will see it?

Children can choose to work digitally or on paper if this is preferred. We would ask that digital work or photos of paper-based work be uploaded in the *Homework* section or via messaging as instructed. Your child's teacher will be able to access submitted work and give feedback where appropriate.

What if my child gets stuck or does not understand what to do?

The teachers will all still be here (providing we are well) so email us a message using STARZ or your child's class email address and we will get back to you as soon as we can, during working hours.

What if I cannot print the activities?

You can request a printed work pack by sending an email to your child's teacher using the class email, but you will need someone who is not isolating to collect it for you as soon as possible. These packs do take time to prepare so we would appreciate it if you only request one if you cannot print or do not have a device to access the resources online. Please ensure that the packs are collected if requested.

What if my child's bubble is closed?

If the whole bubble is sent home to isolate, then we will continue to send work home via STARZ in the same way. More details will also be provided at the time if this were to happen.
