Year 5 Remote Learning

September 2021

What is remote learning?

Remote learning is learning from home when children cannot be at school because of Covid-19.

What will remote learning look like in Upper Phase?

Your child can access the remote learning activities using his or her Microsoft 365 account. Navigate to www.office.com in any browser (or search for office 365) and select Sign In. Your child been assigned individual log in details which will have been stuck into their Reading Logs. If your child does not have this information please contact the class teacher via the following email addresses to request the login details.



All of the children's remote learning resources can be accessed through the 'Assignments' section of 'Microsoft Teams'. Guidance has been sent home and is available on the school website.

Which activities does my child need to do and when?

Where possible, each day your child should complete English and Maths tasks each day as well as other activities such as topic or creative projects. In addition, TT Rock Stars can also be accessed regularly at ttrockstars.com. If your child has a Nessy account he/she should also access the reading and spelling activities for 20 minutes each day. Nessy can be accessed at Log in to play and learn (nessy.com). Login details can be found at the front of your child's Reading Record Book. Please contact your child's class teacher for any of these details.

Reading

Where possible, each day your child should read a book for 20 minutes. The children will still have access to the AR system to allow them to complete regular quizzes at: Welcome to Renaissance Place (renlearn.co.uk) Your child will also have access to the Collins Big Cat e-

library where they will be been assigned a range of books, many of which are on the AR quiz system.

Maths and English

Your child should complete one English and one Maths activity each day. All links and instructions will be available in the assignment. All assignments are marked as 'Isolation'.

Other Subjects

Other activities and projects have be provided within the assignments section for your child to complete during their time in isolation.

What if my child can't do all of that every day?

Our aim is to provide you with four hours' worth of work a day. We understand that sometimes family members may be unwell, working from home or for other reasons it may not be possible to complete everything provided. This is OK. Just do as much as you can, when you can.

Where should my child work and who will see it?

Each assignment has the option to create a new word or PowerPoint document and we would ask that wherever possible work is completed this way. However, we understand that this is not always possible. If your child work's on paper then please upload images of their work to the appropriate assignment.

Once 'Handed/Turned in' the children's work will be visible to the class teacher to review and feedback can be sent back.

What if my child gets stuck on his/her work or has a question?

Children can contact teachers via the Teams chat or as parents/carers via the class email address **during school hours.** They will get back to you as soon as they can.

What if my child cannot access the online content or I cannot print?

You can request a printed work pack by sending an email to your child's teacher using the class email address, but you will need someone who is not isolating to collect it for you as soon as possible. Only request one if you cannot print or do not have a device to access the resources online. Please ensure that the work is collected if requested.

What if my child's class or year group is closed?

If the class or year group is sent home to isolate then we will continue to send work home via Office 365 in the same way. More details will also be provided at the time if this were to happen.
