Headteacher's notes...

Children in Reception enjoyed their visit to Sacrewell Farm yesterday and came back full of stories! Thank you to all those who came and supported with the visit. Congratulations as well to our footballers who played on Tuesday – we have more matches taking place again next week.

The first of the PTA's discos last night went very well and we are looking forward to the next one on Thursday. It was also really good to see so many of you at our 'Meet the Teacher' session after school on Tuesday and I know from your feedback how much you valued the opportunity. Staff enjoyed meeting their new classes for the first time earlier in the week to start the transition process.



Next Wednesday, 12th July, we have our Open Afternoon and this starts straight after school until 4.15pm. Ear Rings

Following recent questions we wanted to clarify our policy on the wearing of earrings during PE.

In line with many other schools our policy means that it is not acceptable to use tape to cover earrings. This applies in both PE lessons and at any clubs. We would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Any child who cannot remove their studs will be given another task to complete during the lesson. Whenever possible children should be able to remove their own jewellery before a PE lesson.

If you plan to have your child's ears pierced, it would be helpful for this to take place at the start of the summer holiday so that the time is available before earrings can be removed.
