This is an opportunity for you to come into school to view some of your child's work from across the year and also to collect their Annual Report which will include results of any statutory assessments, including Y1 Phonics and KS2 SATs. Please note that this is not the time to discuss matters with the teachers and Reports should not be opened until you are at home. Any Reports not collected will be posted home.

Mobile Phones

Only children in Year 6 are permitted to bring mobile phones to school. These must be kept turned off during the day.

Part of our school uniform is that children do not wear hoodies and the only acceptable jewellery are stud earrings and watches. The exception to this is currently children in Y6 who can wear their Leaver's hoodies.
