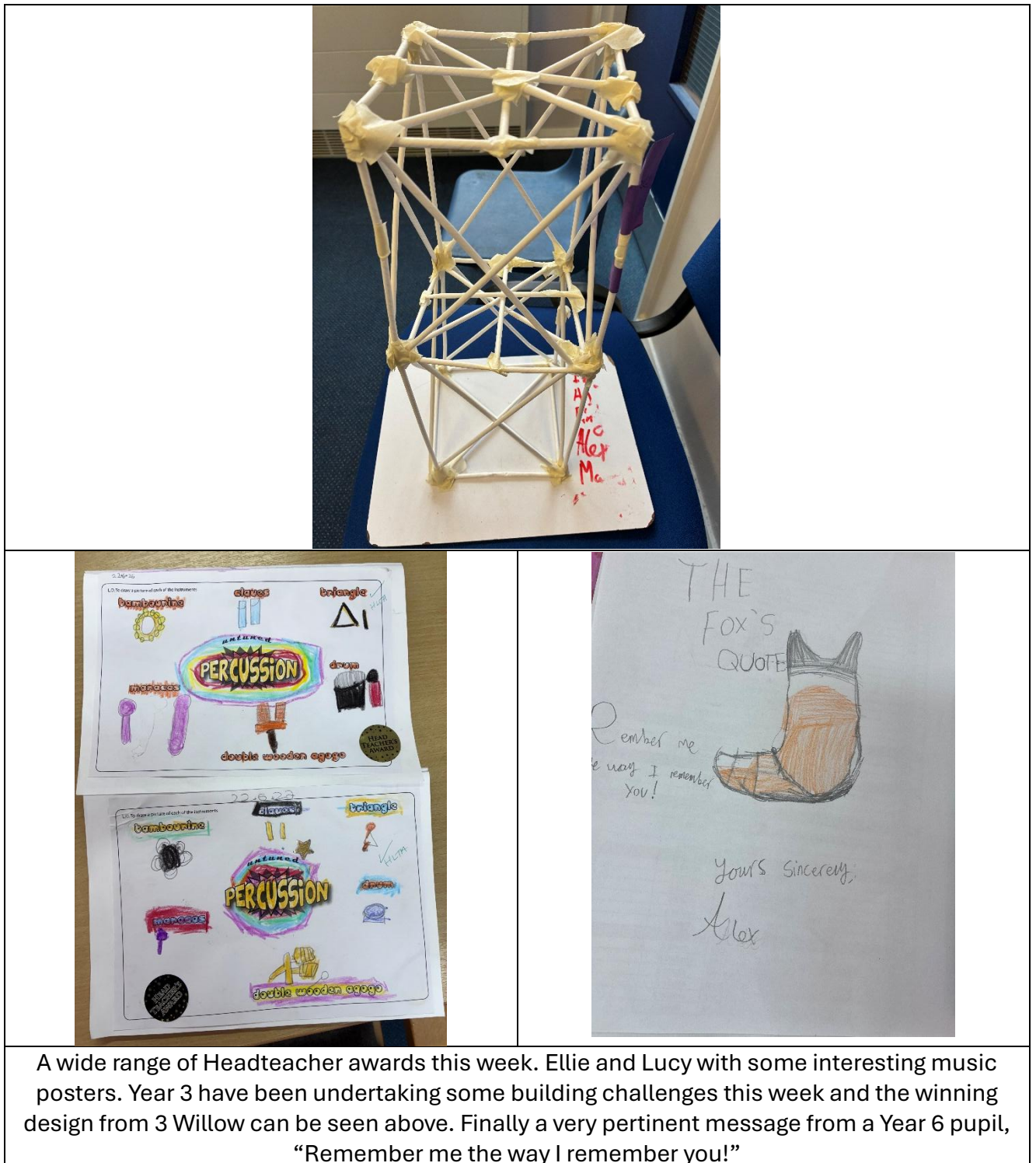
Last of all, 'Come on England' in the World Cup Quarter Final versus Norway! We'll have our fingers crossed on Saturday night.

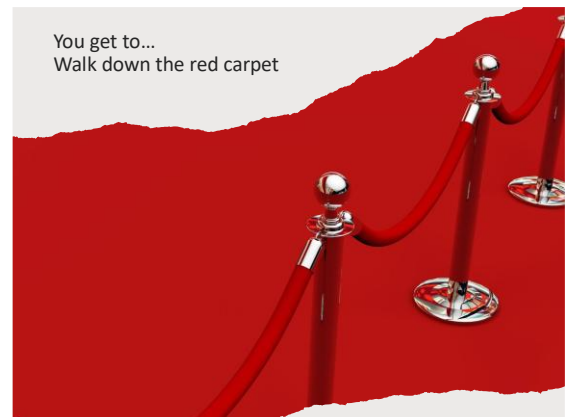


VIP Celebration Assembly this week
