The first full week of term has seen children in Year 5 complete their Bikeability training and the start of swimming in Year 3. Some children have also shared their amazing maths and artwork and it is great to see them doing so well and being proud of what they are achieving. I hope that you found the Curriculum Letters sent home earlier this week informative and that they help you to have discussions with your children about what they are learning at school. The response to 'What have you done today?' is usually "Nothing!' but each day is full of learning and activity.

We are looking at 'Respect' at the moment as this is one of our key 6Rs, thinking about how we treat each other and our school environment. We always try to set a positive example and your support with this is really important – thank you.

Walk to School Week

This year Walk to School week is $20^{th} - 24^{th}$ May. We continue to receive a high number of requests for Leave of Absence during term time. These will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances** and we may ask for more information in order to help us make a decision.

The school cannot be expected to authorise an absence for a holiday during term time. Taking holidays during term time means that pupils miss important school time – both educationally and for other school activities. It will be difficult for pupils to catch up on work when they return to school.

Only in **exceptional circumstances** may a holiday be authorised during term time and these do not involve cheaper costs, family availability or weather conditions. You could be fined if you take your child on holiday during term time without permission.
